

# FENDER FLARE INSTALLATION INSTRUCTION

FORD F-150 04-08 (ALSO STYLE SIDE/FLARE SIDE)

### Parts

Qty (1) Fender Flare Left Front (LF) Qty (1) Fender Flare Left Rear (LR) Qty (1) Fender Flare Right Front (RF) Qty (1) Fender Flare Right Rear (RR) Qty (1) Rubber Seal (enough for four flares's outer edge)

#### Step 1. Pre-Installation



Prefit both driver side and passenger side fender flares to the vehicle before painting or installation. You may remove any moldings, strips or existing flares from the vehicle for fitting or installation. You can cut the fender flare to fit any body side molding.

Step 3. Cleaning




Wash and wipe dry the areas of contact on the vehicle body. Clean the surface and inside edge of the fender flare where the rubber seal is to be attached.



fender flares first. Place the flare on the vehicle. Apply 3 Lever Clips secure it to the hole with 2 existing screws and 1 expanding fastener. Apply 2 Push-In Clips into the mounting slot in the flare and secure it to the vehicle. Fasten the existing factory screw into the original location that were previously removed.

Qty (2) Plastic Expanding Fasteners Qty (16) Push-In Clips Qty (6) Lever Clips Qty (38) Allen Bolt & Nut (Torx Bit required) Qty (8) Self Tapping Screws (see option B)

## Step 2. Painting (optional)



Professional paint or body shop recommended to paint flares. Follow all the paint manufacture specifications to paint the flares. Clean fender flare surfaces with clean water and a mild detergent before painting, do not use lacqure thinner or any solvent based products.

#### Step 4. Apply Rubber Seal



Remove about 1 inch of tape liner from rubber seal and apply it to the flare. Start at one end of the flare along the edge that comes in contact with the body panel. Apply pressure on the tape to ensure adhesion, and trim excess rubber seal at the end.



Use torx bit to tighten allen bolt & put firmly on every pocket of the fender flares. Place the flare on the vehicle. Apply 6 Push-In Clips into the mounting slots in the flare and secure it to the vehicle as shown.

Option B: If condition of fender prevents use of the Push-In Clips you can use the included self tapping screws to secure the flare to the fender.
